




FS-FROST Insert compatible with Frosthaven® How to organize monster standees in their trays








FS-FROST Insert compatible with Frosthaven® How to arrange the trays in the game box

The insert can be used in one of two ways: either with the player trays but no map tiles, or without the player trays but with the map tiles in the game box. Again, please check www.foldedspace.com for detailed images showing which trays go where, as well as how to stack the map tiles if the player trays are not used.

Tray legend (using player trays):

Tray 1 - plastic bases

Tray 2a, b - loot tokens, and scenario aid tokens

Tray 3 - boss & monster stat cards and stat sleeves

Tray 4a - building, summer road and summer outpost decks

Tray 4b - monster & dungeon randomizer, winter road and winter outpost decks

Tray 5, 6 - monster ability cards, and item cards

Tray 7 - challenge & random scenario, town guard,

battle goal, loot, and attack modifier decks

Tray 8 - medium monster standees

Tray 9 - damage and element board tokens

Tray 10 - condition tokens

Tray 11 - small monster standees

Tray 12 - large monster standees and four character mini

Tray 13 - map overlay tiles and monster initiative tokens

Tray 14a, b, & 15a, b - player trays

Tray 16 - map overlay tiles

Note: Tray 12 has space for up to four character mini tuck boxes. these can be three smaller boxes and one larger. Should your party of mercenaries be larger than this, some of the boxes will need to be stored with the other tuck boxes.

Note also that when using the four player trays there is no space in the box for the game map tiles. These should be stored elsewhere, preferrably in the Folded Space map folder product, FS-FHMAP.

FS-FROST Layout without player trays:

The insert can also be used with the game map tiles inside the game box, added on top of the insert trays. In order to provide extra volume for the tiles the four player trays need to be removed.

Four of the smaller character tuck boxes need to be stored as shown in the layout on the right-hand side, that is on top of the other tuck boxes. The smaller map tiles can then be placed on top of the map board, and the larger tiles on top of them. Please check our website www.foldedspace.com for photos of this layout variant.
